## Sub: 2<sup>nd</sup> October – Gandhi Jayanti and International Day of Non-Violence

October 2 is celebrated as Gandhi Jayanti all over the country and also as International Day of Non-Violence by the United Nations which is now observed by 193 Member Nations in the world. Goa PRIs Union is commemorating the 149<sup>th</sup> Birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi by conducting series of activities like competitions, environment friendly cleanliness drives, participatory people's planning campaigns, teaching SDGs etc which will be followed by synergising with the stakeholders to facilitate carrying forward Gandhij's vision of Gram Swaraj on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2018.
